Opportunities exist for greater immersion into occupations in the field, leadership development for career advancement, and mentorship and support programs to cultivate leadership strengths. Additional barriers are cost, quality and availability of education and leadership training.

"California has a workforce shortage. The number of younger adults entering the workforce has slowed, and the total number of retirees continues to grow.
